You have received a traffic ticket. The information on this sheet will help explain your options. Your ticket may include up to 5 violations labeled A thru E. The violations may be CIVIL and/or CRIMINAL. Be sure you read both sides of your ticket **and** this sheet.

For more information on civil traffic violations visit www.pvaz.net Wait 14 business days to contact the court.

If you have a **CRIMINAL/CRIMINAL TRAFFIC VIOLATION** you must appear in court on the date and time on your ticket. Your failure to appear may result in a WARRANT for your arrest.

CIVIL TRAFFIC VIOLATIONS may be paid on or before the court date on your ticket without having to appear in court; however, if the court does not RECEIVE your payment prior to your court date, and you do not appear on your court date, then your driver's license may be SUSPENDED.

2018 <u>Civil Traffic Violations</u>

- Listed on the reverse side are some of the common violations together with the sanction amounts.
- If the violation code on your ticket is not listed below, then you must appear in court on the date and time on your ticket.
- If proof is required to reduce the sanction, then you need to photocopy the document and mail it along with a copy of your ticket and the reduced payment amount **together with the \$37.00 case processing fee**, and other amounts specified above.

Paying civil violations on your Ticket

If you do not want a hearing and wish to admit to the violation(s) follow the instructions below. You may pay:

<u>Online</u> – Visit <u>www.azcourtpay.com</u> and enter your complaint number.

<u>In person/by phone</u> - You may pay in person/by phone on or before your court date at the Prescott Valley Court Monday – Friday 8a – 4:30p.

<u>By mail</u> - You may pay by **check** or **money order** payable to Prescott Valley Court. **CREDIT CARDS** are accepted by completing the information in the next column. You **must** make sure the court **RECEIVES** your payment **on or before** the **court date**.

If there was no insurance coverage when stopped, then to qualify						
for a reduction of the sanction and to avoid suspension of driver's						
license/registration/plates, you must on your court date show the						
Judge the following: 1) proof of purchase of a six (6) month policy						
of insurance, and 2) MVD print-out of driving record reflecting						
no prior insurance convictions in 24 months, or only one prior						
within	36 months.					

NOTES:

- ➤ A \$37.00 case processing fee will be applied in addition to the fine see "Procedure For Paying" set forth elsewhere in these instructions.
- ➤ If you are under age 18 and are cited for ANY moving violation, and are found responsible (first conviction), or plead responsible, you will be required to attend traffic survival school (TSS) by the motor vehicle division (MVD) pursuant to law. If you are eligible for defensive driving school (DDS) and complete a class, the violation will be dismissed and you will not be subject to the requirement to attend TSS.
- > "NO PTS" means no points on driver's license.
- ➤ "DDS" means violation is eligible for Defensive Driving School.

Attending Defensive Driving School (DDS)

For a **CIVIL TRAFFIC** violation you may be eligible to attend DDS. Eligibility is one (1) year from violation date to violation date. You may attend for only one (1) violation. Upon completion

of DDS the violation will be dismissed. You must ENROLL & COMPLETE the class 7 days before your court date, or you are obligated to appear in court at the date and time on your ticket. CRIMINAL TRAFFIC violations DO NOT qualify for Defensive Driving School.

IF YOU HOLD A COMMERCIAL DRIVERS LICENSE YOU ARE NOT ELIGIBLE TO ATTEND DDS.

To find out your eligibility or to enroll in a class contact any Defensive Driving School approved by the AZ Supreme Court.

Requesting a Hearing (civil traffic only)

IF YOU REQUEST A HEARING YOU GIVE UP YOUR RIGHT TO ATTEND DDS.

For CIVIL TRAFFIC violations, you may deny responsibility on or before the appearance date and time on your ticket, by complying with Rule 10(B), AZCvTrP, "The defendant may deny responsibility by appearing in person or by notifying the court in writing. The defendant may, at the same time, tender the civil sanction listed in the court's deposit schedule for civil traffic violations to insure that no driver's license suspension will result from failure to appear."

In Writing: Your written denial of responsibility must be received on or before your court date. If timely received, your plea will be entered and you will be notified of the date, time and location for your court hearing. If not timely received, a default judgment may be entered against you, a civil sanction imposed, and your privilege to drive SUSPENDED.

<u>In Person</u>: Appear on your court date.
