ELIGIBILITY FORM FOR BUSINESS LICENSE APPLICATION

A.R.S. § 41-1080(A)-(C)

Pursuant to Arizona Revised Statutes Section 41-1080 (the 'Legal Arizona Workers Act'), before issuing a license to an individual, the individual must present **one** of the following documents to the Town indicating that the individual's presence in the United States is authorized under federal law. For purposes of applying for a Business License in the Town, an "individual" includes a sole proprietor and a non-statutory partnership/association. A corporation and a limited liability company are examples of 'statutory' business entities.

- Check the box next to the document you are presenting to the Town, indicating lawful presence; **and**
- Attach a copy of said document

	Arizona driver license issued after 1996 OR Arizona non-operating identification license
	Driver license issued by a state that verifies lawful presence in the United States (AK, AL, AZ, AR, CA, CO, CT, DC, DE, FL, GA, HI, IA, ID, IL, IN, KS, KY, LA, MA, MD, ME, MI, MN, MS, MO, MT, NC, ND, NE, NH, NJ, NV, NY, OH, OK, OR, PA, RI, SC, SD, TN, TX, UT VA, VT, WI, WV and WY)
	Birth certificate or delayed birth certificate issued in any state, territory or possession of the United States
	United States certificate of birth abroad
	United States passport
	Foreign passport with a United States visa
	I-94 form with a photograph
	United States citizenship and immigration services employment authorization document or refugee travel document
	United States certificate of naturalization
	United States certificate of citizenship
	Tribal certificate of Indian blood
	Tribal or bureau of Indian affairs affidavit of birth

The foregoing requirement does not apply to an individual if either numbers 1 **or** 2, **and** 3, of the following statements apply. See Arizona Revised Statutes Section 41-1080(B).

- Check the boxes next to the statements that apply to you.

1		The individual is a citizen of a foreign country OR
2		If at the time of application, the individual resides in a foreign country AND
3		The benefits that are related to the license do not require the individual to be present in the United States in order to receive those benefits
